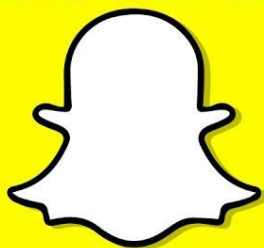




Snapchat New Feature : Snap Maps



Snapchat recently updated their Android and iPhone apps with a new feature called Snap Map which lets you share your current location with other Snapchatters, as well as see their current locations. It may sound like an interesting new feature, but sharing your exact location with all of your Snapchat followers is dangerous, to say the least. Luckily, it's easy to turn this feature off.



This opened up to a flood of complaints from concerned parents and users, who were rather alarmed at the thought of everybody knowing your exact location.

That's why Snapchat included something called "Ghost Mode". By enabling this, you're limiting your location on the map to be seen by **you** and only you.

Enabling Snapchat Ghost Mode

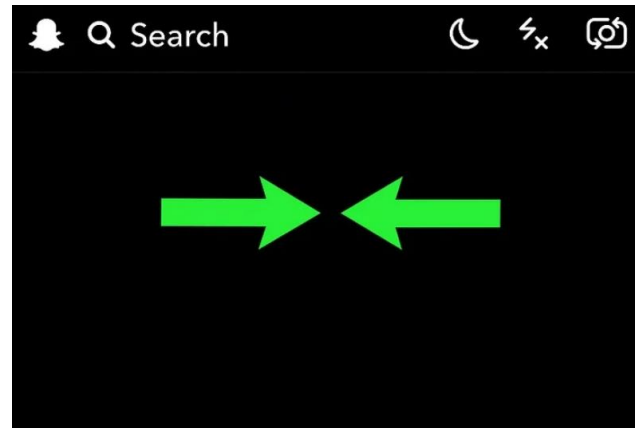
Step 1

Open the Snapchat app on your device.



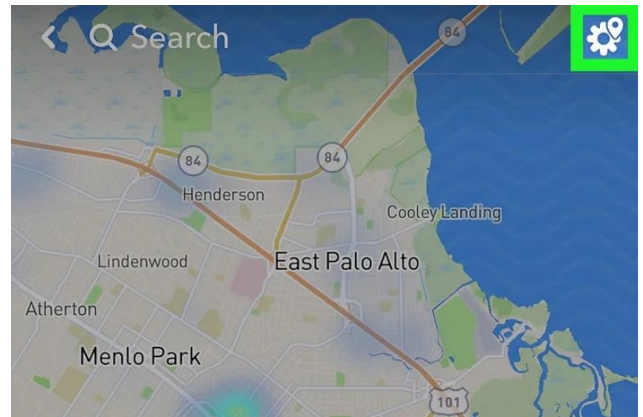
Step 2

Pinch in on the camera screen with two fingers. This will open your Snap map.



Step 3

Tap the settings icon (the white gear icon) in the upper-right corner of the screen. This will open the map settings.



Step 4

Tap the Ghost Mode option. When enabled, only you will be able to see your location.
