

Dear Parents,

This year for homework I will set a mixture of English and maths tasks. Children may wish to do further work as an extension the task given and this is brilliant if they choose to do so. Maths work will also be set weekly on Abacus Online (a separate letter has been sent previously with details and your child's log in).

Spellings will also be sent home weekly to learn. Homework will be a mix of investigation work and spelling practise. All homework will be set on a Friday, and should be handed in for the following Friday.

It is a school expectation that children take home and practise reading their school books. Children also need to be practising their times tables at home as we will have a quiz on a Friday to check progress.

Government guidelines and our policy (available on our website or as a hard copy on request) suggest the following recommendations regarding homework: children in Year 2 should be doing ten minutes a day and in Year 3 up to fifteen minutes. This of course may vary according to individual needs. Our aim is to get it right for each child, so please get in touch if you have any further queries or have any concerns.

I am looking forward to working with you in partnership this year to help your child make excellent progress.
