Staying Safe on Bonfire Night

Leicestershire Constabulary issue the following advice: Bonfire Night is a great time for families and friends to get together and have some fun. However, there are a small minority of people who spoil it by acting dangerously and irresponsibly with fireworks with no thought for others.

It is an offence to both buy and possess fireworks in a public place if you are under 18. It is also an offence to throw fireworks or set them off in public, all of which can carry a penalty of up to a £5,000 fine or even six months in prison.

"Young people in particular need to be aware of the dangers involved to themselves and others when using fireworks and are urged to attend organised displays. Remember, please don't play with fireworks."

Please also remember to wear gloves if holding sparklers
